Web Services

Itinerary: Special Behavior for Open Booking Suppliers

Overview

Open Booking travel suppliers require some different functionality in the Itinerary web service. In this release, the Itinerary web service is updated to include the following function changes when the developer is an Open Booking supplier:

Business Purpose

This enhancement provides targeted functionality for Open Booking Suppliers.

- The Booking Source for POST requests is updated to the internal Concur code for the Open Booking supplier.
- Get List of Itineraries and Get Itinerary Details will not return past trips, and will return a subset of the full itinerary details.
- POST Booking Cancellation is only allowed if the supplier is the booking source for the booking.

Itinerary: Get List of Itineraries Updated to Support Paging

Overview

The Get List of Itineraries function of the Itinerary web service is now updated to support paging through the results. The developer must send the `includeMetadata=true` and `ItemsPerPage={number}` query parameters in the request. The response will provide paging information and the URI to get the next and previous pages.

Business Purpose

This enhancement allows developers to divide the query results into pages.

Travel Profile: New Element in Get Travel Profile

Overview

The Get Travel Profile function of the Travel Profile web service has been updated to include a new element in the <General> parent element, specifying whether the user has the Open Booking User permission. This element is called <HasOpenBooking> and is a Boolean value with the following format: true/false.

Business Purpose

This enhancement provides the ability to view which users have the Open Booking User permission.

Expense Report: New Element in Get Report Details

Overview

The Get Report Details function of the Expense Report web service has been updated with a new element. The

Business Purpose

This enhancement provides more information about expense entry payment.

<ExpensePay> element has been added as a child of the <ExpenseEntry> element. This new element indicates whether the entry was paid by Expense Pay. This element will only be populated in reports that have reached the Processing Payment workflow step.

Quick Expense: New Element in Post Quick Expense

Overview

The Post Quick Expense function of the Quick Expense web service has been updated with a new optional element. The

<ExpenseTypeCode> element allows developers to specify the code for the expense type that the quick expense should be associated with. This functionality currently supports Concur Expense expense types.

Business Purpose

This enhancement provides a method to specify the expense type of a quick expense.

Event Notification: Change to Workflow Step

Overview

The Event Notification web service adds a step to the specified Expense workflow when activated, called External

Validation – Pre-Extract. Prior to this release, the workflow step was added after the Prepayment Validation workflow step. This release moves the External Validation – Pre-Extract step to before the Prepayment Validation step, which is the correct ordering.

Business Purpose

This enhancement eliminates workflow step conflicts.

Purchase Order: New Elements

Resolved Issues

Web Service/ Direct Connect	Issue Description
Imaging	The functions weren't checking that the Concur company had Expense before saving the image, which resulted in 500 errors.
Itinerary	Post Itinerary Details response was missing the <ClientLocator> element.
Trip Approval	Error when posting a trip approval.

Web Service/ Direct Connect	Issue Description
OAuth	OAuth token expiration formula was using local time instead of UTC.
Expense Report	Post Expense Report Attendee was returning an inaccurate number of successful results.
